## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Overall Economic Development Program (OEDP) of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been established and updated annually in accordance with guidelines established by the Economic Development Administration to assist Tribal economic development; and
- WHEREAS, a review of development needs and planned projects indicates that the overall strategy for economic development is essentially unchanged, as follows:
  - 1. The protection of Reservation natural resources water, timber and the land base itself;
  - Controlled development of these resources, including expansion of the recreation industry on-Reservation;
  - 3. Development of human resources by education/training and the provision of jobs; and
  - 4. The provision of basic community infrastructure necessary to improve the quality of life on the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, those projects affecting Tribal water usage (specifically the use of water for agriculture and energy applications) will continue to receive the highest priority in the OEDP Program Projection for FY 1984; a copy of said update attached to this resolution and made a part hereof by reference; and
- WHEREAS, the list of project priorities approved in conjunction with said update has been modified to reflect current requirements for fiscal years 1984 and 1985; said revised project list included as a part of the above-cited OEDP Program Projection for FY 1984; and
- WHEREAS, the <u>Annual OEDP Report and Program Projection</u>, FY 1984-85 is to be submitted to the Economic Development Administration as Addendum No. 6 to the <u>Overall Economic Development Program</u>, FY 1978.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council hereby approves the <u>Annual OEDP Report and Program Projection</u>, FY 1984-85 and incorporates it as Addendum No. 6 to the <u>Overall Economic Development Program</u>, FY 1978.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of  $\underline{6}$  for and  $\underline{0}$  against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
