

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Radio Station, KNNB, through its representative has come before the Tribal Council with a request for monies to underwrite its operation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has previously advised KNNB that Tribal funds were not available for such a purpose and that the proposed budget of the Radio Station would have to be reduced before the Tribal Council could consider any request for underwriting funds and instructed the Station Manager to revise his budget and present it again to the Council for its consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Radio Station has revised its budget and has reduced expenditures necessary to operate the station by a considerable amount in line with the Tribal Council's request; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has studied the proposed revised budget for the Radio Station and concludes that Tribal funds for a limited period of three (3) months can be appropriated to underwrite the cost of operation and maintenance of the Radio Station in an amount not to exceed \$30,971.00; said amount not to be transferred to the Radio Station until such time as the Tribal Administrative Manager determines that the Radio Station has exhausted its present funds; and

WHEREAS, appropriation by the Tribal Council of the foregoing money is premised upon and conditioned upon an understanding that the management of the Radio Station will vigorously pursue grants and other alternative sources of financing and underwriting and will present a report within three months to the Tribal Council of efforts it has made in this area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appropriates the sum of \$30,971 and no more, over the next three months for the operation and maintenance of the Tribal Radio Station, KNNB; said monies not to be transferred until all present radio funds are exhausted.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requires the management of the Tribal Radio Station to provide the Tribal Council with a report three months hence as to all efforts it has made to apply for grants, alternative financing, and private underwriting for its operational and maintenance costs.

The foregoing resolution was on November 3, 1983, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against with 1 abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
