FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation Board of Directors has come before the Tribal Council for Council approval for the Radio Station to seek funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to a 638 Grant, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after some discussion, concludes that permission should be granted to the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation Board of Directors to seek such funding.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of the Board of Directos of the Apache Radio Station (KNNB) to apply for funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to Public Law 93-638.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that said application for monies shall be for Fiscal Year/85 monies available pursuant to Public Law 93-638.

The foregoing resolution was on December 15, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of   9   for and   0   against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
