RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has updated its Road Construction priorities, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Roads and Forestry Committees have set its priorities as follows:

1. Housing Access Roads
2. Sunrise Ski Area Road
3. Canyon Day Farm (pave) present contract calls for prime & seal.
4. Route 61, Diamond Creek, grade, drain & surface
5. Route 70-71, Seven Mile to I.D. Ranch, grade, drain & pave
6. Route 12, Oak Creek Stockman's Road
7. Route 55, Rock Creek to Rt. 8.
8. Upper Cibecue Bridge
9. Route 48, Amos Ranch to Forestdale
10. Route 12, Cibecue to Grasshopper
11. Fairground roads
12. Orchard vehicle bridge and Canyon Day vehicle bridge.
13. Rock creek to Hawley Lake (21 miles) present contract calls for prime and seal, issue as to paving; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs construct roads as the priorities are listed, and


WHEREAS, the priorities may be changed at any time by the Committee and/or the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the above-recommendation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee should seriously reconsider priorities to cover much-needed roads that are used daily; particularly, with roads in areas involved in tribal water-rights developments.

The foregoing resolution was on December 20, 1983 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 19, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
