RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that presently no one has been assigned to the position as Fire Chief for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Broadus Bones, a tribal member, is presently the Fire Chief for the Bureau of Indian Affairs Fire Department, and
- WHEREAS, it is suggested to the Tribal Council that Mr. Broadus Bones would be a fit and proper person and is well-qualified to be appointed as the Official Fire Chief for the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Voluntary Fire Department and the Tribal Council concurring with that recommendation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Mr. Broadus Bones as the Official Fire Chief for the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Voluntary Fire Department, effective immediately.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that said appointment shall continue until further action by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on January 11, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
