RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, funding for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Youth Service Center has become severely limited, and
- WHEREAS, Revenue Sharing funds appropriated to the Youth Service Center in 1983 through Resolution No. 83-44 have not all been used, and
- WHEREAS, the previous needs addressed by these Revenue Sharing funds have been adequately met.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the remaining \$4,800.00 in the Revenue Sharing Account of the Youth Service Center be approved for payment of daily operating expenses including salaries.

The foregoing resolution was on January 12, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
