## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 83-173 contains a provision for review and adjustment at no less than a three-month interval for stumpage revaluation, and
- WHEREAS, Fort Apache Tibmer Company hereby requests that an adjustment should be made to the ratio percent that is now being assessed, and
- WHEREAS, the logging has ceased for the year and no salvage logs are coming in to offset the high stumpage Fort Apache Timber Company is now paying under the current formula, and
- WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company recommends a percentage rate that will give a reasonable profit return to the company and still be a fair and equitable stumpage rate to the Tribe.

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the stumpage valuation system herein specified shall supercede any other pricing arrangements of Forest Products, not covered by specific contract reference, under the terms and conditions of several contracts, between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and its subsidiary enterprise, the Fort Apache Timber Company as set forth ir. Resolution No. 83-173.

The foregoing resolution was on January 12, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
