BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Mr. & Mrs. Wilbur Hinton to sponsor a Sunrise Ceremonial Dance for their daughter during the weekend of May 26 and 27, 1984 on the farmland of Mr. & Mrs. Bert Hinton, Sr.

The foregoing resolution was on January 25, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
