RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has recognized that alcoholism is a major health problem on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation which has been demonstrated in the Tribal Specific Health Plan, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has continually supported the efforts of the Rainbow Treatment Center in its efforts to rehabilitate recovering alcoholics, and
- WHEREAS, a Tribal Resolution is required by Indian Health Service to demonstrate the Tribal Council's approval of the Indian Health Service Contract proposal for services provided by the Rainbow Treatment Center.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves of the contract proposal for the Rainbow Treatment Center as a component of the Tribal Health Authority.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the contract funding will be approximately \$87,287.00 and that the term of the contract is from January 1, 1984 to October 31, 1984.

The foregoing resolution was on February 01, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
