RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilman, Alvino Hawkins, had been requested by the President of the East Fork Community for his assistance in obtaining Land Claims money to finance a trip for twenty-one (21) children and twenty (20) chaperons to Phoenix Zoo on March 29, 1984, and
- WHEREAS, the cost breakdown of the trip is set forth in a letter from Mrs. Paulene S. George, President, East Fork Community and attached to this resolution by reference, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the letter from Paulene S. George and concludes that such a field trip would be worthwhile for the children and good experience for them, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further concludes that the petition signed by parents of the children and interested members of the East Fork Community should be submitted with the request for the Land Claims money to the Bureau of Indian Affairs as a demonstration of Community support for the request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the East Fork Community for the use of the Land Claims money to sponsor and finance a field trip for 21 children and 20 chaperons to the Phoenix Zoo.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that at the request of the Tribal Council, the East Fork Community parents had prepared a petition, which is attached, reflecting community support for the field trip and for the use of the Land Claims money for that purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on March 23, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
