## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware that a Tribal Election is scheduled for the first Wednesday of April, 1984, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election regulations require that a Tribal Precinct Committee be appointed by the Tribal Council to undertake the responsibilities of the Tribal Election on April 04, 1984, and
- WHEREAS, there are nine precincts throughout the reservation that will need a JUDGE, 2 CLERKS, a MARSHALL and an ALTERNATE in each precinct, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Board had met and selected 45 people to serve on the Tribal Precinct Committees, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council with the Tribal Election Board reviewed the listings recommended by the Tribal Election Board and are agreeable with the selections.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the attached listings of Tribal Precinct Committees are hereby appointed to serve on the Committees on April 04, 1984 with compensation.

The foregoing resolution was on March 26, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
