

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Avilla (Ethelbah) Hoskie, a tribal elderly, has come before the Tribal Council with an emergency request that she be considered immediately for a house under the Home Improvement Program, and


WHEREAS, Mrs. Hoskie has been very ill and is presently convalescing, has no spouse to assist her in the support of her children, and is in desperate and obvious need for a comfortable shelter with sanitary bathroom facilities so that she can recover from her illness, and

WHEREAS, the plight of Mrs. Hoskie cries out for consideration by the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of Mrs. Avilla (Ethelbah) Hoskie for a house to be constructed pursuant to the Home Improvement Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby declares Mrs. Hoskie's situation as desperate and one requiring emergency relief on the part of the Home Improvement Program administrator; and therefore requests that her home be given the highest priority by the Home Improvement Program

The foregoing resolution was on March 07, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
