

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has interviewed two candidates who have been pre-selected by the Commercial Center Board of Directors and Personnel Department for the position of Commercial Center Manager, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has completed its interview of the two most qualified candidates and has determined based upon their interview that Mr. David Shadle of Pinetop, Arizona would be best qualified to be employed by the Tribe as the Manager of the Commercial Center, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has notified the Director of the Personnel Department to contact Mr. Shadle and advise him of his appointment conditioned upon Mr. Shadle and the Tribe agreeing upon his annual salary.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby selects Mr. David Shadle as the General Manager of the Tribe's Commercial Center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the appointment of Mr. Shadle as the Manager of the Commercial Center is contingent upon Mr. Shadle and the Tribe arriving at a mutually agreeable salary for said position.

The foregoing resolution was on March 07, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
