- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is committed to quality judicial services for the youth of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the future of the Tribe depends on the healthy development of the youth of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes the problems associated with placing juvenile offenders in the adult jail, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes the need for an emergency shelter facility for the youth of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the staff of the Youth Service Center continues to actively seek non-tribal funding sources, and
- WHEREAS, the Youth Service Center has requested the amount of \$16,730.00 for operating costs for the months of March and April, 1984.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the appropriation of the amount of \$16,730.00 for the operation of the Youth Service Center through the month of April, 1984.

The foregoing resolution was on March 08, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
