RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation Board of Directors was originally formulated in 1979, with an appointment of ten (10) members of who nine (9) are voting members and one (1) in a non-voting capacity, and
- WHEREAS, the ten (10) board members were selected in an effort to give representation to all communities for the development of KNNB FM PUBLIC RADIO STATION, and
- WHEREAS, the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation Board of Directors currently has two board vacancies, and
- WHEREAS, the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation Board of Directos hereby recommends the vacancies not be filled, thus reducing the size of the Board for operational purposes of KNNB, and
- WHEREAS, KNNB advises the Tribal Council that its Board of Directors has amended the By-Laws for the apache Broadcasting Corporation to reduce the number of directors on the Board from ten (10) to eight (8) Board members, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this amendment to the By-Laws.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that the Radio Board bacancies not be filled thereby reducing the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation Board of Directors to seven (7) voting members and one (1) non-voting capacity in accordance with the recently amended Bh-Laws for the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation.

The foregoing resolution was on March 08, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
