

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Rolland Armstrong, Jr. and his wife, June (Alsenay) Armstrong requests permission of the Tribal Council to sponsor a Tribal Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for their daughter, and


WHEREAS, the dates scheduled for the dance will be on June 22 thru 24, 1984 weekend, and

WHEREAS, the dance and related activities are being planned to be held at Seven Mile on the family farmland on the above dates.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Mr. and Mrs. Rolland Armstrong, Jr. to sponsor a Tribal Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for their daughter on June 22, 23, and 24, 1984 weekend at Seven Mile on the family farmland.

The foregoing resolution was on March 23, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
