RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Tribe's governing body, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is committed to the delivery of Social Services to its tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to recontract Social Services from the Bureau of Indian Affairs as provided under 93-638, the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, and
- WHEREAS, the services provided within this contract shall include, General Assistance; Child Welfare Assistance; including a group home; Miscellaneous Assistance; the Tribal Work Experience Program and Family and Community Services, and Custodial Care for Adults, and
- WHEREAS, the authority granted under this resolution to recontract for Social Services is for a period of three (3) years, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Chairman or his designated representative to negotiate such contract and/or amendments.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the submission of a proposal to recontract Social Services to provide ongoing services to members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to execute the contract and/or any amendments and to affix his signature to any and all documents to consumate this contract on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on March 23, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
