

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Raymond Endfield, Jr., on behalf of the McNary Community, has advised the Tribal Council that there is a great need to repair or remodel the McNary Community Building so as to provide a suitable, comfortable facilities for doctors and nurses to provide infant child care services and other community activities, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Endfield requests that Revenue Sharing in the approximate amount of \$3,000.00 be designated for the repair of the community building, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Endfield's request on behalf of the McNary Community is a valid and worthwhile request and that it should be granted.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the appropriation of approximately \$3,000.00 from Revenue Sharing funds for the repair of the McNary Community Building for the purposes set forth herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests that Mr. Raymond Endfield, Jr. act as liaison with full authority to insure that the Revenue Sharing funds are utilized for the repair of the McNary Community Building as requested.

The foregoing resolution was on March 23, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
