- WHEREAS, the ceremony and related activities are being planned and scheduled for the weekend of June 8, 9, and 10, 1984 at Cibecue, Arizona.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of Levi and Gussie (Tessay) Dehose to sponsor a Traditional Sunrise Ceremonial Dance for their granddaughter, Laura Mae Endfield at Cibecue, Arizona on the weekend of June 8, 9, and 10, 1984.

The foregoing resolution was on April 17, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
