FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Councilmembers elect, Mrs. Marjorie Grimes, Mrs. Gertie Lupe and Mr. Herbert Tate, have requested funding from the Tribal Council so that they can attend a training session and seminar in Reno, Nevada on Tribal Government, Tribal Constitutions and organization of Indian Tribes so as to acquaint them with the process of Tribal Government, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with their request and hereby grants funding to attend the seminar and workshop on Tribal Government.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants funding for Mrs. Marjorie Grimes, Mrs. Gertie Lupe, and Mr. Herbert Tate to attend the seminar in Reno, Nevada for April 24-26, 1984.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs the three councilmembers elect to contact Ms. Berta Bones of the Tribal Chairman's Office for travel and other financial arrangements for the seminar.

The foregoing resolution was on April 17, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
