- WHEREAS, Ryan and Maryelle (Kessay) Quintero requested permission of the Tribal Council to sponsor a Traditional Sunrise Ceremonial Dance for their daughter, Gwendolyn Burnette, and
- WHEREAS, the ceremonies and related activities have been planned and scheduled for the weekend of July 27 and 28, 1984 at the old Tribal Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of Ryan and Maryelle (Kessay) Quintero to sponsor a Traditional Tribal Sunrise Ceremonial Dance for their daughter, Gwendolyn Burnette, on the weekend of July 27, 28, 1984 at the old Tribal Fairgrounds in Whiteriver, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on April 18, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
