RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous resolution, approved a five-year lease with no option to renew for the Hawley Lake Community Building at the rental rate of \$750.00 per year effective March 1, 1984, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Tribal Attorney that a representative of the Hawley Lake Homeowners Association requested that the Tribe approve a three-year lease rather than a five-year lease at the rate of \$750.00 per year, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after some discussion, agrees with such modification.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants a lease to the Hawley Lake Homeowners Association for use of the leased land upon which sits the Hawley Lake Community Building for a period of three years at the annual rent of \$750.00 per year, payable on March 1, 1984 and the first day of March thereafter.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney to draft the appropriate lease form with the Bureau of Indian Affairs and further authorizes the Tribal Chairman to sign said lease.

The foregoing resolution was on April 18, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
