- WHEREAS, the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and other members of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe wish to publicly recognize the outstanding contributions of the outgoing Council members, Raymus Albert, West Anderson, Sr. and Adam Lupe, Sr. to the health, welfare and economic development of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, these Councilmen: Raymus Albert, District II, Cedar Creek-Carrizo-Forestdale; West Anderson, Sr., District IV, North Fork-Whiteriver-Canyon Day, and Adam Lupe, Sr., District I, Cibecue-Oak Creek-Grass-hopper have provided conscientious service and have worked diligently for the betterment of the Tribal people, for the protection of their natural resources for future generations and have served well and honorably in their Councilmen positions over the years, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to express its gratitude with an appropriate plaque setting forth all of the names of the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby personally acclaims the contributions of Raymus Albert, West Anderson, Sr., and Adam Lupe, Sr. to the betterment of the health, welfare and economic development of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- 3E IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to expend the necessary funds from the Tribal Contingency fund to purchase and engrave the plaques.

The foregoing resolution was on April 24, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
