RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Governing Body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to recontract for Fiscal Year 1985 and each year thereafter for the Higher Education Grant, Johnson O'Malley Supplemental Funds, Adult Vocational Training Grant, and Adult Education Grant of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and
- WHEREAS, the P. L. 93-638 Education Program contracts have, in the past, been successfully administered, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has authorized the Tribal Education Director to develop, plan, negotiate, execute and administer the contracts and/or any amendments thereto, and
- WHEREAS, the authority granted under this resolution to the Tribal Education Director is to run concurrent with the term of the Contract October 1, 1984 to September 30, 1985 and each succeeding year thereafter.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Education Director is hereby authorized to plan, develop, negotiate, execute and administer the Grants and Educational Funds and Contracts discussed herein.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and/or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman are authorized and directed to sign the negotiated Educational Contracts for FY/85 for the following programs:
 - 1. Higher Education
 - 2. Johnson O'Malley
 - 3. Adult Vocational Training
 - 4. Adult Education (GED)

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b,i,k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Jecretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
