## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is submitting an application for a grant under the Community Development Block Grant Program for Indian Tribes, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe elects to submit demographic data that is unpublished and not generally available in order to meet the requirements of the Application Process, and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development requires the Tribe to provide assurance that such data meets the standards outlined in 24 CFR 571.300(c), and
- WHEREAS, generally available, published data is substantially inaccurate or incomplete.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby certifies that the Tribal demographic data will be submitted to the Department of the HUD as follows:
  - (1) that the Tribal data it will provide has been systematically collected;
  - (2) that the Tribal data to be submitted is to the greatest extent feasible, independently verifiable; and
  - (3) the Tribal data differentiates between reservation and Bureau of Indian Affairs area populations.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman are authorized and directed to sign documents and; otherwise, act to complete a grant agreement for this purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on May 21, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
