

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilman, Herbert Tate, representative of District IV, which includes the Canyon Day Community has come before the Tribal Council and requested financial assistance on behalf of his constituents to repair the Canyon Day Community Building to make it suitable for community meetings, elderly programs and other activities, and

WHEREAS, Councilman Tate requests that Revenue Sharing Funds be appropriated for that purpose in the amount of \$13,535.00 which is based upon estimates he received to complete the repairs necessary, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Revenue Sharing Funds are appropriate for this purpose and that the Canyon Day Community should have a safe and substantial building for their community meetings, elderly programs and other activities, and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Federal Regulations pertaining to Revenue Sharing Funds, this meeting should be considered as the first public meeting and that two (2) more public meetings must be scheduled by Mr. Tate in accordance with the Federal Regulations before Revenue Sharing Funds can be finally appropriated for the project.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the appropriation of Federal Revenue Sharing Funds in the amount of \$13,535.00 for the purpose of repairing the Canyon Day Community Building.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in accordance with Federal Regulations this meeting shall constitute the first public meeting of three (3) necessary prior to the appropriation of the Revenue Sharing Funds described herein and requests that Mr. Tate schedule two (2) more public meetings in the near future in order to satisfy the requirements of the Federal Revenue Sharing Program.

The foregoing resolution was on May 21, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
