## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 84-38, the Tribal Council reduced the rates for water and sewer services on the Fort Ax. he Indian Reservation and further enacted a policy that Tribal members over the age of sixty (60) years who own or who are buying their home and who are head of their household should receive sewer and water services without charge, and
- WHEREAS, severe budgetary problems for the continuing operation and maintenance of the Tribal Utility Authority and Tribal Water System now mandates that Resolution No. 84-38 be revised, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after a thorough examination of the budgetary data, maintenance problems and cost of operation concludes that the water and sewer service rates should be restored to the rates existing prior to the adoption of Resolution No. 84-38 except for tribal members over the age of sixty (60) years who own or who buy their own home and are the head of their household.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby re—establishes the original rate for water and sewer services as follows:
  - 1. For inside plumbing connected to the city sewer system, water \$10.00 per month; Sewer, \$2.00 per month.
  - For indoor plumbing connected to a septic tank, \$10.00 for water per month.
  - 3. For a standing water pipe and no indoor water plumbing, \$5.00 per month.
- WE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that the Utility Authority continue to waive water and sewer charges for tribal members who are sixty (60) years old or older who own their home and who are the head of the household to which the water and sewer services are being provided by the Tribal Utility Authority.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that the reinstatement of the original water and sewer rates shall become effective on the next monthly billing date and shall be carried out by the Tribal Utility Authority without further orders from the Tribal Council.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Resolution No. 84-38 is hereby rescinded to the extent that it conflicts with any provision of this resolution.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that a copy of this resolution be delivered to Mr. Paschal Johnson, Sr., Manager of the Tribal Utility Authority.

The foregoing resolution was on May 29, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 18, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
