RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Durena Wood, a tribal member from the Canyon Day Community has come before the Tribal Council with a request for assistance on behalf of her two nephews, Samuel Baha and Gilbert Baha, whose parents are now deceased and who are now living in the family home their parents built, and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Wood reports to the Tribal Council that Samuel Baha is not well and suffers from chronic spells and that Gilbert Baha is also sick and is presently unable to properly support himself, and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Wood further advises the Tribal Council that the home in which Samuel and Gilbert Baha are presently living is very old and is in great need of repair and that financial assistance is necessary to rehabilitate and clean the home to make it a comfortable place to live, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mrs. Wood's request deserves attention and consideration by the Home Improvement Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Home Improvement Program to place Samuel and Gilbert Baha on the list of persons who are to receive financial assistance for the repair of their home.

The foregoing resolution was on August 9, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Seftion 1 (i) of the Amended Comstitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
