RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe, through a P. L. 638 Contract is in the process of planning for construction and remodeling of housing on the reservation; said project during FY/84 to be funded in part by FY/83 HIP Program carryover monies and Bureau FY/84 reprogrammed Agriculture Extension Service funds, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service (IHS) has indicated that IHS monies may become available to cover the costs for water supplies service lines and sewage disposal facilities to additional new or remodeled homes, and
- WHEREAS, a project proposal for provision of sanitation facilities under P.L. 86-121 has been completed and submitted by IHS to Area Office to service approximately fifteen (15) additional homes, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requests IHS to assist the Tribe and its tribal members in dire need of housing to service these homes with water and sewer lines by allocating funds in the budget to service these homes, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Vice-Chairman and Tribal HIP Coordinator request that this be a priority; said proposal to be coordinated with present planning of the HIP Project.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorize and direct the Chairman and/or Vice-Chairman in conjunction with IHS and Bureau perstanel to execute all necessary documents in order to proceed with the above-described project.

The foregoing resolution was on June 6, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
