RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has requested that the Bureau of Indian Affairs rebuild the bridge on Route No. 45, known as Stago Bridge, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous Right-of-Way, 80 feet in width; beginning at the intersection of Route 46, running north-easterly a distance of .611 miles, and connecting with Route 55.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants to the Bureau of Indian Affairs a gratuitous Right-of-Way as recorded on a map on file in the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona, to which reference is hereby made.

The foregoing resolution was on June 28, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bh-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
