RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, The Chairman of the Tribal Council has advised the Tribal Council that he has received a request from Tonita Larzelere, an enrolled member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, for financial assistance to participate in a Youth and Student Ambassador Program sponsored by the General Federation of Womens Clubs and the Experiment in International Living; and
- WHEREAS, the Chairman advises the Tribal Council that Miss Larzelere is the only Native American who is going to participate in the program and that the General Federation of Womens Clubs, which is sponsoring Tonita, will pay for her roundtrip air fare to and from the United States, as well as her daily room and board while in Switzerland and the Continent, but that Tonita requests assistance for roundtrip travel and expenses from Whiteriver to New York City, the point of departure to Switzerland, and
- WHEREAS, it is a rare occasion that a Tribal Member has the opportunity to represent the Tribe, the State of Arizona and the United States as an "Outbound Ambassador", and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Miss Larzelere's request should be granted and that an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00 should be appropriated in order to defray her roundtrip expenses to and from New York City from Whiteriver, including air fare and room and board and other sundry necessities.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a sum not to exceed \$1,000.00 in financial assistance for Tonita Larzelere in order that she might take part in the Youth Ambassadorship Program to Switzerland this summer.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to appropriate the money for these purposes and further offers its best wishes to Tonita for a safe and enjoyable journey and to hearing about her experiences in Switzerland upon her return.

The foregoing resolution was on 06-28-,1984, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
