RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the term of Office of Associate Tribal Court Judge Kay Lewis expired on July 17, 1984, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes that Judge Lewis has had over ten (10) years experience as a Judge and has attended annually continuing education courses for the judiciary, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Judge Lewis has satisfactorily performed his duties as a Tribal Judge and has expedited his case load in furtherance of the administration of justice, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further concludes that Judge Lewis should be reappointed to another four-year term as Associate Tribal Court Judge.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reappoints Tribal Judge Kay Lewis to an additional four-year term commencing July 18, 1984.

The foregoing resolution was on July 18, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for 1 abst & 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratific by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
