- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the attached 1984/85 Tribal member Hunting and Fishing Regulations for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation as recommended by the Manager of the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on July 18, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f & i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
