Financial Assistance for Agatha Lupe

WHEREAS, Agatha Lupe, former Miss White Mountain Apache and presently reigning Miss World Eskimo, has come before the Tribal Council and requested financial assistance in order to be able to travel to Alaska and transfer her crown to the new Miss World Eskimo and for travel expenses to Sheridan, Wyoming to participate in the Miss Indian America Contest as a representative of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the list of accomplishments achieved by Miss Lupe and concludes that she has represented the White Mountain Apache well in many areas and should receive Tribal Council support in order to participate in the ceremonies in Alaska as well as Sheridan, Wyoming; and


WHEREAS, Miss Lupe has requested the approximate sum of \$900.00 to defray her travel and per diem expenses to participate in the two ceremonies.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the expenditure of \$900.00 for Agatha Lupe to attend the Miss World Eskimo Ceremonies in Alaska and the Miss Indian America Contest in Sheridan, Wyoming and further authorizes the Tribal Chairman to allocate approximately \$900.00 from tribal funding sources and to deliver the same to Miss Lupe for her travel and per diem.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby extends its best wishes to Miss Lupe for a safe and successful journey to Alaska and Sheridan, Wyoming and looks forward to her return.

The foregoing resolution was on July 17, 1984, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior

on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
