RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to select new commissioners for the Tribal Housing Authority Board of Commissioners and to establish their terms; and,
- WHEREAS, it has been moved that Raymus Albert be appointed for a term of one year, Ernie Crocker for a term of two years, Judy Dehose for a term of three years, Gertie Lupe for a term of four years, and Alvino Hawkins for a term of five years; and,
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that said persons should be appointed immediately to serve on the Housing Authority Board of Commissioners for the term of years so designated.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints the following persons to the Board of Commissioners for the Tribal Housing Authority for the following terms:

Raymus Albert - 1 year Gertie Lupe - 4 years Ernie Crocker - 2 years Alvino Hawkins- 5 years Judy Dehose - 3 years

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that said appointment shall be effective immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on July 23,1984, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
