

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Cibecue Community Building has developed serious roof problems that require immediate repairs, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Foam Company of Pinetop has submitted an estimate of \$8,000.00 for the necessary repairs, and

WHEREAS, there are Revenue Sharing Funds available to repair said Community Building and is a proper expenditure of said funds.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the allocation of \$8,000.00 of Revenue Sharing Funds for this project; this public Council meeting being the first of three public meetings required under Federal Revenue Sharing regulations for final approval of the proposed project.

The foregoing resolution was on August 8, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
