

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Project known as Arizona 16-30 consisting of one hundred fourteen (114) Mutual-Help Units has progressed to the state of preliminary engineering, and

WHEREAS, it is essential to retain an architect and engineer to develop this program as prescribed by HUD.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Commissioners of this Authority enter into an agreement with Gilbert Honanie, Jr. of Phoenix, Arizona to design and engineer this Project.

The foregoing resolution was on August 9, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section.1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
