RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Ellen Tessay of Cibecue has requested that the Tribal Council approve a land assignment of certain land in her name, and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Tessay advises the Tribal Council that her request was recommended by the Land Board for approval at a recent Land Board Meeting, but her name was inadvertently omitted from the Land Board Minutes, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that Mrs. Tessay's request for land assignment should be approved on the basis of her representation to the Council that her request had already been recommended for approval by the Land Board, but that her application was inadvertently omitted from the recommended listing.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the land assignment approval for Mrs. Ellen Tessay, and of Cibecue.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs Mrs. Tessay to return to the Land Board and obtain a legal description of the land assignment to her so that the Land Board records may be corrected and so as to avoid any future conflict because of incomplete records.

The foregoing resolution was on August 8, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
