## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the 1984 Capital Budget for Sunrise Ski Resort Complex set aside \$300,000.00 for the construction of a bottom Day Lodge at Apache Peak, a Pizza Restaurant, Rental Sports and Ski School Building, and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors for the Sunrise Recreation Ski Area has determined that the \$300,000.00 allocated for these projects would be best re-allocated to the following capital expenditures by way of a transfer of funds, specifically:
  - \$80,000.00 For a Snow Bus to transport employees, especially elderly employees to the various work stations on the nountain.
  - (b) \$70,000.00 To purchase a modern telephone system for the Day Lodge, Hotel and Apache Peak Lodge ir. anticipation of further expansion.
  - (c) \$150,000.00 For interior furnishings to the Apache Peak Top Lodge, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with the recommendation of the Board of Directors for Sunrise Ski Area and hereby authorizes the transfer of \$300,000.00 in capital budget funds for the purposes set forth above.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Sunrise Ski Area Management to transfer funds from their capital budget as previously planned to a modified capital budget for the purchase of a Snow Bus for \$80,000.00; \$70,000.00 to purchase a telephone system for the Sunrise Day Lodge and Hotel, Apache Peak Top Lodge and for future expansion and interior furnishings for Apache Peak Top Lodge in the amount of \$150,000.00.

The foregoing resolution was on August 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 7for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V. Section 1 (i & k) of the Amende Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
