

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE

WHEREAS, Councilman, Raymond Endfield, Jr., advises the Tribal Council that there is a need for a safe and secure nurses's station, suitable for a visiting Nurse and patients in McNary, and

WHEREAS, he further advises the Tribal Council that one or more Indian Health Service nurses are willing to donate time in McNary, but a suitable nurses's station must be constructed or an existing building modified to facilitate the service, and

WHEREAS, Councilman Endfield requests that Revenue Sharing funds or any other available funding source be explored for purposes of funding this project which is estimated to cost approximately \$3,000.00 for modification or construction of a room for the nurses's service station, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that there may be Revenue Sharing funds available for this purpose and that this previously noticed public meeting shall constitute the first public meeting and discussion of the merits of the request for such funding.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of Councilman Raymond Endfield, Jr. on behalf of the people in McNary for Revenue Sharing funds in the amount of \$3,000.00 for the modification or construction of a room suitable for a nurse's station to provide medical service for the people in McNary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby designates this date as the first public meeting and discussion of the merits of this request for Revenue Sharing Funds.

The foregoing resolution was on August 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
