

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Thomas LeRoy Amos has requested a homesite assignment in the North Fork Sub-Division, and


WHEREAS, the Land Board has recommended that a homesite application be approved for Thomas LeRoy Amos on his chosen site, and


WHEREAS, the assignment to Thomas LeRoy Amos is personal to him only, he being an enrolled member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, is non-transferable and cannot be inherited, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Thomas LeRoy Amos's request and the recommendation of the Land Board should be approved and grant be made to Thomas LeRoy Amos for a homesite in the North Fork Sub-Division.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a homesite land assignment for Thomas LeRoy Amos in the North Fork Sub-Division with the condition that said land assignment shall be for the life time of Thomas LeRoy Amos only and shall revert thereafter to the White Mountain Apache Tribe as tribal property.

The foregoing resolution was on Aug. 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
