RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal JTPA Department has requested approval from the Tribal Council for a land assignment comprised of eleven (11) acres in the Whiteriver Industrial Park Area in order to conduct their trapping, tanning, and sales training program, and
- WHEREAS, the Director of the JTPA Program advises the Tribal Council that the Tribal Land Board has approved the business site requested, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that JTPA Program should be granted the eleven (11) acres that they request for their training and tanning operation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of JTPA Program for a land assignment comprised of eleven (11) acres in the Whiteriver Industrial Park Area for the purpose of providing a business site for the JTPA trapping, tanning and sales training program.

The foregoing resolution was on August 16, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
