WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is committed to Sound Game Management practives, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Elk Herd is in excellent condition, and

WHEREAS, the harvest of four (4) additional mature bulls will not harm the herd in any way, and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Enterprise can generate \$28,000.00 in additional income from the sale of four (4) additional permits.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that four (4) additional elk permits are hereby authorized for the 1984 Trophy Elk Hunt.

The foregoing resolution was on September 05, 1984 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f & i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
