## PESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Artie L. and Loween (Johnson) Harvey, tribal members, have requested Tribal Council assistance and recognition of the purchase of an FMA house and an assignment of the land upon which it is constructed, located in the Seven Mile Community, and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Harvey advises the Tribal Council that they have completed the paper work with FHA to transfer ownership of the house to them, but requests that the Tribal Council officially acknowledge and affirm that the land is assigned to them, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council explains to Mrs. Harvey that with FHA homes, the land is always transferred with the house and that the lease of the land to the FHA by the tribe is irrevocable for a period of twenty-five (25) years.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby officially recognizes the ownership of the FHA house and assignment of the lease pertaining to that house to Artie L. and Loween (Johnson) Harvey based upon their representations and information that they have; in fact, completed all of the necessary FHA requirements for the purchase of the house.

The foregoing resolution was on January 09, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
