RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, a complaint has been brought to the attention of the Tribal Council that a non-member of the Tribe residing in McNary is an undesirable person on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, specifically, charges were made that the particular non-member in question has induced people to drink excessively and has committed_violent acts on frequent basis in McNary, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that this individual has challenged the authority of the Tribal Council and Tribal Government Agency to stop his conduct and has verbally stated that regardless of his behavior, the Tribal Council lacks the power to remove him from the premises, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that appropriate representative of the Tribe should conduct an investigation of these allegations with the assistance of the Police Department and report back to the Tribal Council his findings upon completion of his investigation with the recommendation for action.
- BE IT PESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Herbert Tate to meet with the Tribal Police Department and any other appropriate persons or agencies for the purpose of investigating the several serious complaints of violent behavior against the individual discussed at the Council Meeting.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Herbert Tate, upon completion of his investigation, report his findings to the Chairman and Vice-Chairman and Tribal Council at the next regularly scheduled monthly meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on January 09, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
