## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has been advised by Councilmember, Gertie Lupe, that Odette Fuller has offered
  to make a land exchange with the Tribe whereby she
  would transfer all rights and ownership of the
  lease and buildings for the gas station/store
  located in the Salt River Canyon to Apache Enterprise in exchange for an assignment of two lots for
  business purposes across the highway from the high
  school; and,
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that such an exchange would be in the best interests of the economic development of the Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the transfer of the land and property now assigned to Odette Fuller in the Salt River Canyon, comprising some 3.5 acres with a gas station and store, to Apache Enterprise in exchange for an assignment of two lots for business purposes across from the Alchesay High School.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Land Board to complete the necessary procedures to carry out this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
