RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it was reported to the Tribal Council that tribal member,
Raymond Wright, lost his house by fire and that he has requested
the tirbe to assist him to renovate his house by providing him
with lumber, and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that hog lumber from the Fort Apache Timber Company be donated to Mr. Wright so that his house can be repaired immediately.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Fort Apache Timber Company to donate one bundle of hog lumber to Mr. Raymond Wright of the Seven Mile Community for the repair of his home which was destroyed by fire.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
