## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that it is extremely important that the Council meet and discuss the contents of the proposed revision of the Tribal Code, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney requests that the Tribal Council set dates for a series of meetings at which only the Tribal Code would be discussed so that the Code can be implemented for the protection and enhancement of the Tribe's sovereignty, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that dates should be scheduled for study of the proposed code.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney, Robert Brauchli, and Lafe Altaha, Chairman of the Law and Order Committee, to meet and propose a series of meeting dates for the Tribal Council to review the Law and Order Code.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
