RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that Ronald Dazen, a tribal member, is in great need of a home and has no place to go for shelter, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised of the particulars of his need and agrees that he should be assisted in his request for a home.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Ronald Dazen be assigned a house from the list of BIA houses that will soon be turned over to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests that Superintendent Russell Bradley prepare a list of the BIA houses that are to be turned over to the tribe with description as to their condition for immediate occupancy and that said list be filed with the Office of the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
