RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Council Member, Gertie Lupe, has complained that the hiring and travelling freeze order issued by the Tribal Administrative Manager is not being complied with by the Sunrise Ski Area; specifical y, that non-members are being hired over tribal members in violation of the freeze order, and
- WHEREAS, the factual basis for this complaint is disputed between the Sunrise Ski Business Manager, Raymond Endfield, Jr. and Gertie Lupe, pro and con, and
- WHEREAS, Council Member, Gertie Lupe is directed to meet with Raymond Endfield, Jr. for the purpose of reviewing Sunrise Compliance with the hiring and travelling freeze order, and
- WHEREAS, the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Councilman Alvino Hawkins requested to be included in this meeting.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Chairman Lupe, Vice Chairman Reno Johnson Council Members, Alvino Hawkins and Gertie Lupe, and Raymond Endfield, Jr. meet as soon as possible for the purpose of reviewing Sunrise Ski Area's compliance with the hiring and travelling freeze order issue by the Tribal Administrative Manager.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
